



FOOTPRINTS: Respite in a happy and safe environment

FOOTPRINTS is a local. volunteer-driven, not-forprofit program dedicated to providing respite care for families with children 13 years of age and under who have been diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorders.

Program Highlights

The program at FOOTPRINTS is geared towards the skills and interests of the children involved. Parents are required to provide information about their child to allow the Program Consultant to create a program suitable for their child.



FOOTPRINTS can include, but is not limited to: free play, arts and crafts, story time, outdoor playtime, and group activities, with a focus on social interactions between participants. A child's level of participation is strictly voluntary and supported by the program's staff and volunteers.

> Respite services are provided at a cost of

\$30 for a 5-hour session \$18 for a 3-hour session

Payment is due upon arrival and a receipt will be issued.

Making a Difference for Families

For many families, raising a child with Autism Spectrum Disorder "on" being 24/7. means FOOTPRINTS' mission is to provide families with a few hours of respite. It is knowing a difference being made that drives FOOTPRINTS forward, as stated by one mother:


